It brings together universities of applied sciences and engineering faculties with the common goal of enhancing the quality, relevance and accessibility of international academic experiences. Through long-standing trust and regular exchange, the network creates a **framework for cooperation across borders**. A yearly network meeting, hosted in rotation by one of the partner universities, offers a platform to align strategies, initiate projects and strengthen partnerships. But collaboration is continuous: throughout the year, member institutions work together on curriculum development, teaching innovation and the organization of joint activities.
